Male Candidates

- **100 metre race** in 16 seconds
- **1.6 Km Race** in 6.5 minutes
- **Long Jump:** 3.65 metres in 5 chances
- **High Jump:** 1.2 metres in 3 chances
- **Short put 16 LBS:** 4.5 metres in 3 chances

Female Candidates

- **100 metre race** in 18 second
- **800 metre race** in 4 minutes
- **Long Jump:** 2.7 metres or 9 feet in 3 chances
- **High Jump:** 0.9 metres or 3 feet in 3 chances

SSC CPO Medical Test

Criteria for the Medical Test is given below:

- **Minimum Near Vision:** N6 (better eye) and N9 (worse eye)
- **Minimum Distant Vision:** 6/6 (better eye) and 6/9 (worse eye)
- Must not have knock knee, flat foot, varicose vein or squint in eyes
- Eye standards should be without visual correction of any kind even by glasses
