The SSC Stenographer selection process comprises of two stages:

1. Computer-Based Examination
2. Skill test in Stenography

SSC Stenographer CBT exam important pointers

- Candidates have to complete the CBT exam in **2 hours**
- One mark is awarded for each right answer and **0.25 marks** are deducted for every wrong answer.

Skill Test – All those candidates who clear the computer-based exam have to appear for the skill test in stenography. The skill test is basically conducted to test the speed of candidates.

In this stage, candidates are given a dictation in English or Hindi for 10 minutes. Candidates, in to qualify in this test, are required to type the dictation at the speed of 100 words per minute for Stenographer Grade C post and 80 words per minute for Grade D post.

After the candidate completes the skill test, the result is declared. The final SSC Stenographer result is based on the marks scored in both the stages of the SSC stenographer selection process.
